COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

WE ARE ALL RESPONSIBLE

STAY CLEAN

Please try to wash your hands as often as possible with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place. We will make sure soap is available in our bathrooms and hand sanitizer is placed strategically throughout our facility.

SOCIAL DISTANCE

Try to remain six feet apart from non-family members. Our coaches will limit the amount of close contact with athletes during training and will wear a mask during training sessions. To limit the number of people in the building, parents are prohibited from entering the training area but can drop their children off in the front lobby.

FACE MASKS

Face masks are required to enter the building and athletes are required to wear face masks during their training session. The Pennsylvania Department of Health has mandated that face masks be worn indoors and outdoors away from home.

HEALTH CHECKS

All staff members will be screened daily for any symptoms relating to COVID-19. We ask that all players, parents, and family members do their own daily assessments prior to attending a scheduled training session.

REDUCING RISK

Throughout the year we will continue to monitor local, state, and national guidelines and make changes to our COVID-19 Plan as more information becomes available.

PLAN OF ATTACK

CHECKING INTO THE FACILITY

Appointments are required to enter the facility. Players will be required to check in at the front desk of the Flanigan Center before the start of their scheduled lesson or training session. Players should arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to the start of their training session.

SPECTATORS

November through February, spectators will be prohibited from watching any training sessions. Parents may enter the building to drop off their children and may return for pick up following their scheduled training time.

POSITIVE TEST CASES

In the event of a parent, player, or staff member testing positive for COVID-19, that person will be automatically removed from the facility and required to test negative before returning. Any persons directly exposed to the positive person will also be removed from the facility and may not return until they can confirm a negative test result.
